



## NOTICE ON APPLICATIONS FOR THE AMENDMENT OF LICENCE CONDITIONS

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

NERSA will, in terms of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No.40 of 2004), decide on the licence conditions amendment applications referred to herein.

Notice is hereby given that Sasol Gas (Pty) Ltd & Egoli Gas (Pty) Ltd is applying for amendment of the conditions of its licences in terms of Sections 24 (1) (a) of the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) ("Gas Act"). The amendment applications are as below:
