
NOTICE OF NERSA'S DECISION TO PUBLISH DAMPLAAS KRAGBRON (PTY) LTD PRIVATE DISTRIBUTOR TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2024/25 FINANCIAL YEAR

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator at its meeting held on 16 May 2024 resolved on a consultation process to be followed for the Municipal Private Distributors tariff approval process. NERSA will follow the notice and comment consultation process. All tariff applications will be published on the NERSA website and social media platforms in order to solicit written comments from affected parties. NERSA's decision will be made, taking into account written comments from the affected stakeholders and analysis performed by NERSA officials.
