
INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION BY FFS TANK TERMINALS (PTY) LTD FOR ITS PETROLEUM STORAGE FACILITY

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA or 'the Energy Regulator') is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator invites the public to comment on the tariff application by FFS Tank Terminals (Pty) Ltd for its petroleum storage facility in Maydon Wharf, KwaZulu-Natal Province for the period 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2027.
