



**NOTICE ON NERSA'S CONSULTATION PAPER AND A PUBLIC HEARING ON
ESKOM'S APPLICATION FOR CONGESTION CURTAILMENT TO BE A
CONSTRAINED GENERATION ANCILLARY SERVICE**

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006) ('the Act'), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd ('Eskom') has submitted an application to NERSA in terms of section 21(4) of the Act, seeking the Energy Regulator's approval for congestion curtailment to be treated as a constrained generation ancillary service.
